



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a locked room or place away from children, animals, food, feedstuffs, seed and fertilisers. Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple rinse container before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulation. Do not burn empty containers or product.

For refillable containers: Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply for refill or storage.

DIP DISPOSAL

DO NOT dispose of spent dip on site. Spent dip waste must be transported to a facility that can lawfully receive it.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Poisonous if absorbed by skin contact or inhaled or swallowed. Repeated minor exposure may have a cumulative poisoning effect. Will damage eyes and skin. Will irritate the nose and throat. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapour. When preparing dip and using the prepared dip wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, protective waterproof clothing or a PVC apron, elbow-length chemical resistant gloves and impervious footwear and face shield or goggles. If clothing becomes contaminated

with product or wet with spray remove clothing immediately. If product in eyes, wash it out immediately with water. If product or dip on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. After use and before eating drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use, wash gloves and goggles and contaminated clothing.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, splashed on skin or in eyes, or inhaled, contact a Poisons Information Centre (phone Australia 131 126) or a doctor at once. Remove any contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly. If swallowed, activated charcoal may be advised. Give atropine if instructed.
